



**Reading Bingo** – when you colour in 5 tasks in a row (diagonally, vertically, horizontally) show the grid (and tasks) to your teacher for 3 House tokens. Make sure that each task is recorded in your reading log – and make sure you write the task number, the Author, Title and Illustrator of each book. You must have a NEW BOOK for each task you do. **NOTE: You will need to do about 3 tasks a week to complete this in the term!**

<p><b>Task 1</b> Read a <b>picture book</b> to a younger family member or friend. Write a paragraph summarising the story. Include title, author, illustrator.</p>	<p><b>Task 2</b> Read 6 poems from a poem book, or internet. A) Write the name of each poem and author, and b) write 3 sentences about which one you enjoyed the most and why.</p>	<p><b>Task 3</b> Read a chapter from a non fiction book, and write down 5 facts that you have learnt. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 4</b> Read a bedtime story to a parent or family member before you go to bed.</p> 	<p><b>Task 5</b> Read a book about animals (either non fiction or fiction) Include the title, author and illustrator. Write a paragraph about whether you would recommend this book to a friend or not, and state your reasons why</p>
<p><b>Task 6</b> Read a fairy tale or a well known myth and legend. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 7</b> Read for an hour just for enjoyment. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 8</b> Read a book about a main character who is a boy/girl your age. Write 3 reasons why you are the same as that character, and 3 reasons why you are different to that character. Make sure to include title &amp; author.</p>	<p><b>Task 9</b> Read a comic book of graphic novel. Make sure to include the title, author.</p>	<p><b>Task 10</b> Read a Sci fi book, or a book about the future, robots, space, time travel or aliens. Draw a picture of a scene from the book that you liked – label the drawing or write a brief sentence about what is happening in the picture. Make sure to include the title, author.</p>
<p><b>Task 11</b> Read a non fiction book about another country other than NZ. Write 5 reasons explaining how this country is different to NZ. Draw a picture of their flag or national animal or national sport. Colour it in. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers</p>	<p><b>Task 12</b> Read a magazine or newspaper article. Stick the article in your book and write why you were interested in reading it and what you learnt from it.</p>	<p><b>Task 13</b> <b>FREE CHOICE</b> *Read a book of your choosing*</p>	<p><b>Task 14</b> Read a book that is written like a letter or a diary. Make sure to include the title, author.</p>	<p><b>Task 15</b> Read a recipe you would like to make and then make it! Get a photo as proof, or get a family member to write a comment on how it tasted. Write the recipe in your book.</p>
<p><b>Task 16</b> Read a book by a NZ Author. Write down the city the book is set in. Find out 7 things about that city and record it in a creative way. Make sure to include the title, author.</p>	<p><b>Task 17</b> Ask a parent or older family member to read a book or chapter to you. Talk about the story afterwards and write down 3 things you discussed. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 18</b> Read a journal story from a school journal. Write down the title, author and number of the journal. How could you make that story more interesting for students your age?? Explain your answer.</p>	<p><b>Task 19</b> Choose a topic which interests you such as dinosaurs, weather, fashion, Tupac – any topic you want!! Write down the topic, and read about that topic on some websites. Write 5 things you have learnt and make sure you write down the website that you got the information from.</p>	<p><b>Task 20</b> Read a book and then draw 3 pictures which show the beginning, middle and end. Make sure to include the title, author and page numbers.</p>
<p><b>Task 21</b> Read a book you have read before! Make sure to include the title, author. Write if you enjoyed it more or less the second time and why.</p> 	<p><b>Task 22</b> Ask your parent or teacher to recommend an author or book for you to read. Then find it and read it. If they are not sure, choose from Roald Dahl, Suzanne Collins, David Walliams, J.K. Rowling, C.S.Lewis</p>	<p><b>Task 23</b> Choose a book to read and design a new cover for it. Create a new title which matches the story and create on A4 paper. Include the original title and author on the back.</p>	<p><b>Task 24</b> Read a book by an American author. How is life different in USA to NZ? Write a paragraph or 4 ways. Make sure to include the title, author.</p>	<p><b>Task 25</b> Read a book online or from the Duffy E-Library. Write the title, author.</p>

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
